

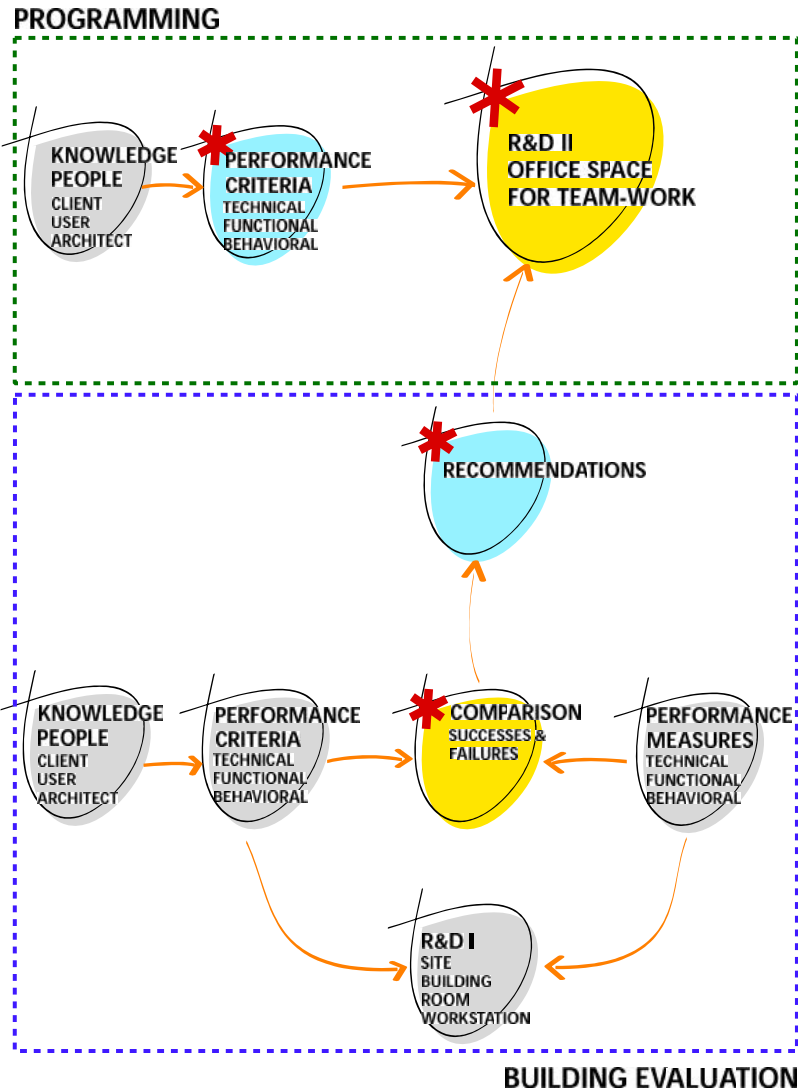

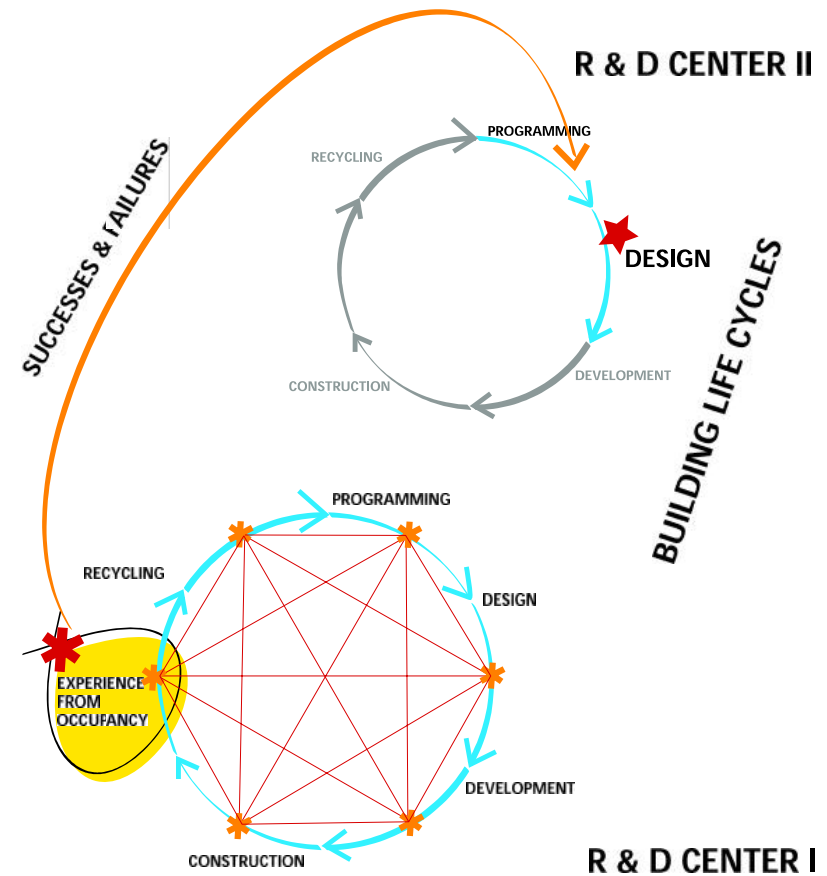
PERSPECTIVE: ... more things we have to do!

- develop tools & modules for all BPE phases



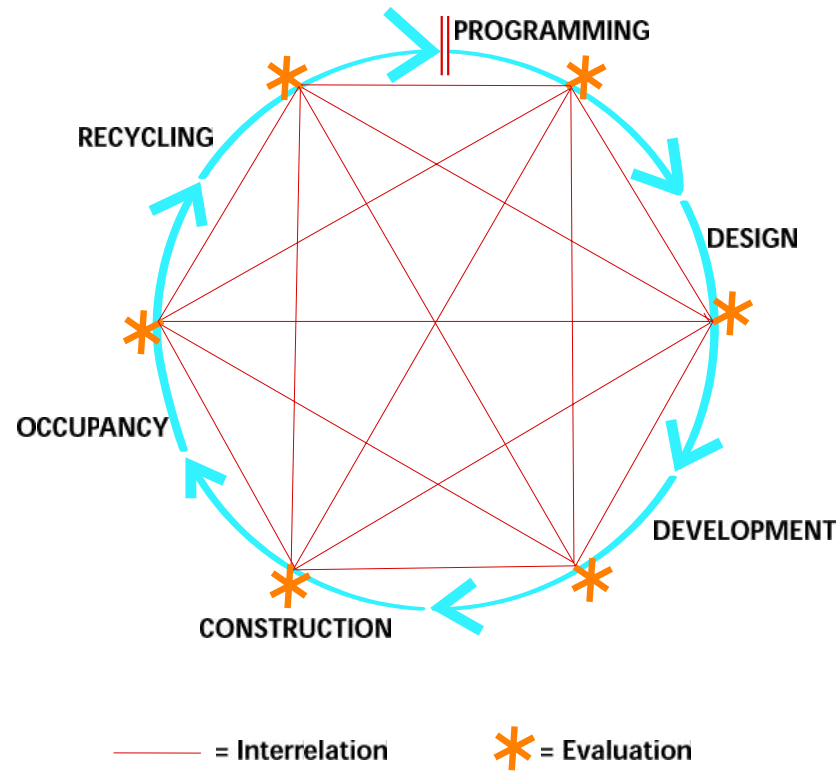
CONCEPT of work process

1. evaluate the existing R&D center I (POE)

- (3. review the design)



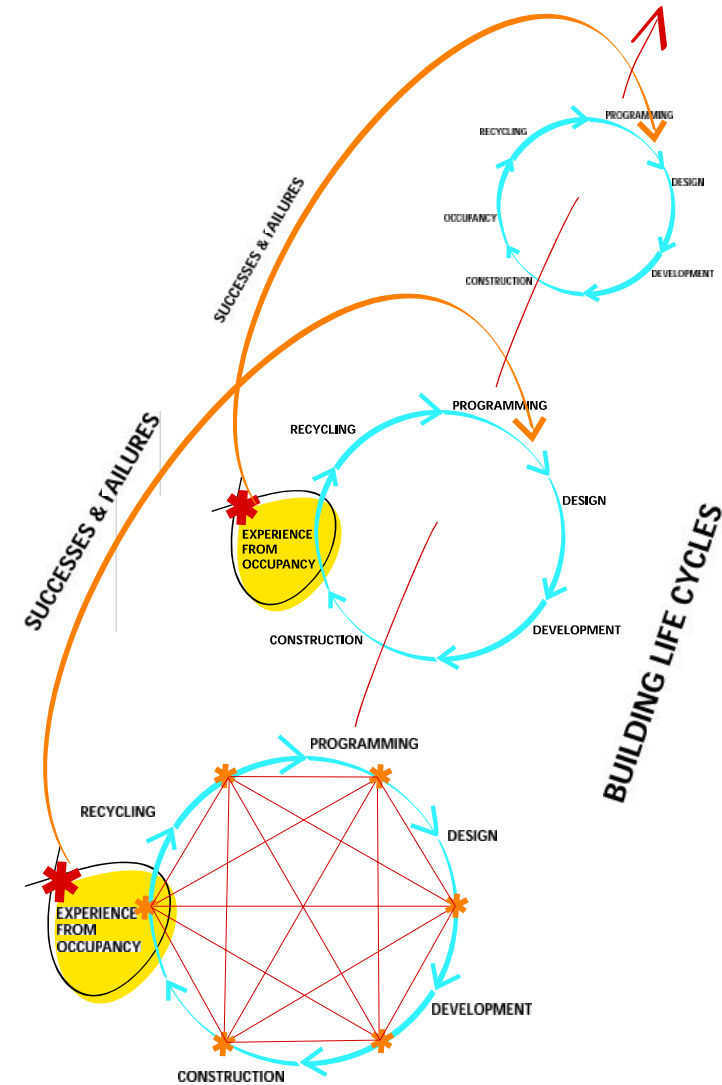
SUMMARY: better R & D center II by BPE

- program & design review are based on objective criteria



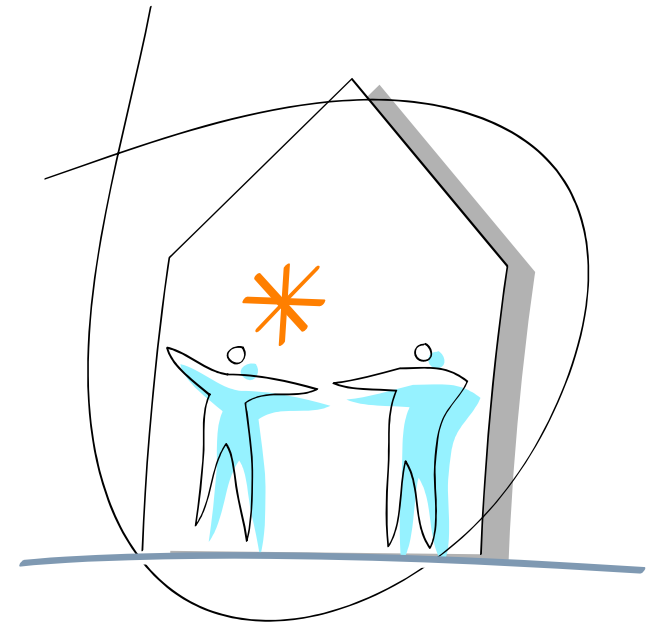
BUILDING LIFE CYCLE as background for BPE
