# 3. Legal bases

The collection of personal data for organising the BiCAB conference is based on the consent of the data subject in accordance with Article 6(1) point (a) EU GDPR.

# 4. Data transfer

As a matter of principle, we do not transfer your personal data to third parties. It is processed by HSBI for the purpose mentioned under section 2.

### 5. Processing period / Erasure of data

Collected data will be erased immediately after the end of the BiCAB conference.

# 6. Your rights as data subject

As data subject, you can assert your rights granted by the EU GDPR at any time:

- The right to obtain information from the contact person named under 1.2 as to whether or not personal data of yours are being processed, and if so, which personal data are being processed (Art. 15 EU GDPR),
- The right to request rectification or completion of the data that concern you (Art. 16 EU GDPR),
- The right to erasure of data that concern you in accordance with Art. 17 EU GDPR,
- The right to obtain restriction of processing data in accordance with Art. 18 EU GDPR,
- The right to withdraw the consent you have given at any time (from the moment of withdrawal onwards). The lawfulness of the processing taking place from consent until withdrawal shall not be affected by this (Art. 7(3) EU GDPR),
- The right to object to future processing of data that concern you in accordance with Art. 21 EU GDPR.
