





HEALTH INSURANCE IN GERMANY

So you applied for German statutory insurance, what now?

- Students who applied for German public health insurance will need to confirm their insurance status by
 - a) handing in your SEPA direct debit with European IBANs (bank details)
 - b) applying for your insurance card



HEALTH INSURANCE IN GERMANY

The representative from TK (German public health insurance company) Judith Males is here today and can

- I help answer your first questions
- I If you are a TK student: help continue your application



GOOD TO KNOW

I EU Citizens: Your EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) covers your stay.

I Turkish Citizens: Your AT11 covers your stay.

I BUT: If you wish to work (part-time work, student job etc.), your EHIC/AT11 is not sufficient.

You will need to take up German health insurance!

- I German insurance:
 - Free choice of health insurance provider in Germany
 - Read your contract/policy carefully!



WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU FEEL ILL?

- First contact is a general practictioner:
 - I They can help with many types of illnesses.
 - I If you require more specialized help, the practicioner will refer you to a specialist.
- I Doctor's have "Open Consultation Hours": Mondays to Fridays
 - I If it is urgent: Call ahead to find out the open hours of a doctor's office. Prepare to wait for some time in these general office hours.
 - I Make an appointment if it's not urgent: Waiting will take considerably less time.

- The lists will also give you very useful tips on what to do at the doctor's!



WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY?

At night or over the weekend:
 Call medical service number 116117.
 The phone agent will then tell you which clinics are still open.



- 2. Go directly to an Emergency Room.
- 3. Call 112 (for an ambulance).

TIP: You can get medicine at a pharmacy. However, they are closed in the evenings, on Saturday afternoon and on Sunday. If you urgently need medication, you can check which pharmacy is open after-hours (Notdienst): https://www.aponet.de/service/notdienstapotheke-finden

ACCOMODATION IN BIELEFELD

Rent is paid

- I in the first week of each month
- I by direct debit: Your rent is directly withdrawn from your bank account
- → Direct Debit = free of charge from a German or other European bank account

It is not possible to pay in cash!

Good to know:

Rental payment for September/October: To give you a little bit of time, the dorm will withdraw the rent for both months after the first week of October!






